

MINUTES  
HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 391

February 9, 2026

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 391 (the "District") met in regular session in person and by videoconference, open to the public, on the 9th day of February, 2026, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Houston, Texas, outside the boundaries of the District, and the roll was called of the members of the Board:

and all of the above were present, thus constituting a quorum.

Also present at the meeting were Shawn Austin, Paul Jacob, and Chris McWilliams, residents of the District attending by videoconference; Sergeant Pleytez of Harris County Constable's Office; Sarah Valladares of Storm Water Solutions, LLC ("SWS"); Danae Dehoyos and Simon VanDyk of Touchstone District Services; Cole Caraway of LJA Engineering ("LJA"); Demitra Berry and Mara Baeza of McLennan & Associates, LP ("McLennan"); Debbie Arellano of Bob Leared Interests; Randy Davila of Inframark Water & Infrastructure Services ("Inframark"); and Greer Pagan, Elizabeth Cone, and Kerri Houck of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP ("ABHR").

PUBLIC COMMENTS

The Board opened the meeting for public comments.

Mr. Jacob stated concerns regarding the agreement with the development adjacent to the District, also known as Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 592 ("HCMUD No. 592"). He requested more information regarding the agenda item for the sidewalk project that is partnered with Harris County Precinct 3. Mr. Jacob requested that the Board consider maintaining the medians in the District.

Mr. McWilliams thanked the Board for adding the reports provided to the Directors during the meeting to the District's website. He then inquired regarding the perimeter fencing around HCMUD No. 592.

There being no further public comments, the Board moved to the next agenda item.

## MINUTES

The Board considered approving the minutes of the January 12, 2026, regular meeting. After review and discussion, Director Broom moved to approve the minutes, as presented. Director Force seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

## SECURITY MATTERS

Sergeant Pleytez discussed security matters in the District, and discussion ensued.

## FINANCIAL AND BOOKKEEPING MATTERS

Ms. Berry reviewed the bookkeeper's report, a copy of which is attached, and presented the District's bills for payment. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to approve the bookkeeper's report and payment of the District's bills. Director Force seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

## ASSOCIATION OF WATER BOARD DIRECTORS CONFERENCES

The Board discussed the Association of Water Board Directors winter conference. The Board then considered authorizing attendance at the summer conference. After discussion, Director Blackwell moved to approve reimbursement of all eligible expenses for Directors who attended the winter conference, which the bookkeeper confirmed were submitted in accordance with the District's guidelines, and to authorize attendance of any interested Directors at the summer conference. Director Shook seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

## REVIEW ARBITRAGE REBATE REPORT FOR SERIES 2015A BONDS

The Board reviewed the Arbitrage Rebate Report for the District's Series 2015A Bonds, prepared by Omnicap Group LLC. Mr. Pagan stated no payment is owed to the Internal Revenue Service for excess earnings on bond funds.

## TAX ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTIONS MATTERS

Ms. Arellano reviewed the tax assessor/collector's report, delinquent tax report, and checks presented for payment from the tax account. A copy of the tax assessor/collector's report is attached. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to approve the tax assessor/collector's report and payment of the bills from the tax account. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

## ADOPT RESOLUTION CONCERNING EXEMPTIONS FROM TAXATION

Mr. Pagan reviewed previous tax exemptions with the Board. Mr. Pagan then presented and reviewed a Resolution Concerning Exemptions from Taxation reflecting that the Board grants a general residential homestead exemption of 20% (but not less than \$5,000) and grants an exemption of \$75,000 of the appraised value of residence homesteads of individuals who are disabled or are sixty-five (65) years of age or older. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to adopt the Resolution Concerning Exemptions from Taxation and direct that the Resolution be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Force seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

## ADOPT RESOLUTION REGARDING DEVELOPMENT STATUS FOR 2026 TAX YEAR

Mr. Pagan discussed the "truth-in-taxation" property tax calculations and tax levy process for water districts and stated that Chapter 49 of the Texas Water Code establishes three main categories for water districts, based on a district's development status and/or tax rate. He reviewed the definitions for each of the three categories and said the Board must annually determine the District's category for that tax year and follow the associated notice and levy provisions in the Texas Water Code.

Discussion ensued regarding the District's development status. After fully considering relevant data, information, and statutory definitions, the Board determined that the District is a Developed District for the 2026 tax year.

Following review and discussion, Director Broom moved to adopt a Resolution Regarding Development Status for 2026 Tax Year establishing the District as a Developed District for the 2026 tax year, pursuant to Section 49.23602, Texas Water Code, and direct that the Resolution be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Force seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

## DISCUSS COST SHARING AGREEMENT WITH HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION FOR STREETLIGHTS, AND AUTHORIZE APPROPRIATE ACTION

Mr. Caraway updated the Board on the new accounts for streetlights located on Louetta Road, Cypresswood Drive, Mueschke Road, and Cypress Rosehill Road. He stated that the request to provide service has been sent to CenterPoint Energy.

## NEW DEVELOPMENT ADJACENT TO DISTRICT

Director Broom reviewed information provided by MAK Development, the developer of HCMUD No. 592, and discussed concerns brought up under public comments.

## ENGINEERING MATTERS

Mr. Caraway reported on engineering projects within the District. A copy of the LJA engineering report is attached.

Mr. Caraway updated the Board on the water plant no. 1 recoating and appurtenances.

The Board discussed the sidewalk enhancement project with Harris County Precinct No. 3 and requested that the landscape architect prepare a letter addressed to the Villages of Cypress Lakes Homeowners Association ("HOA") requesting their consent to the encroachments.

The Board discussed metering of the waterlines between the District and HCMUD No. 592.

Mr. Caraway reviewed a proposal to rehabilitate the storm sewer outfall for a cost of \$84,885.00, a copy of which is attached to the engineering report. He recommended approving the proposal without the installation of riprap and stated that the new cost of the proposal will be \$66,270.00.

Mr. Caraway updated the Board regarding compliance with America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018. He stated that LJA is preparing the required reports and will present them for Board review at a future meeting.

Following review and discussion, Director Blackwell moved to (1) approve the engineering report; and (2) approve the proposal in the amount of \$66,270.00, submitted by LJA, to rehabilitate the storm sewer outfall, as discussed. Director Shook seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

## LAKE AND TURF MANAGEMENT REPORT, INCLUDING APPROVAL OF PROPOSALS FOR NECESSARY REPAIRS OR REPLACEMENTS, IMPROVEMENTS, RENEWAL OF PERMITS, OR LANDSCAPING AGREEMENTS

The Board discussed lake and turf management matters and reviewed a proposal from Lake Pro, Inc. to replace fountain no. 5 at lake no. 3 for a cost of \$13,425.00. Following review and discussion, Director Broom moved to approve the proposal to replace the fountain. Director Force seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Ms. Valladares then reviewed a maintenance report, a copy of which is attached.

The Board discussed the maintenance of the medians throughout the District and Director Broom noted that the HOA currently maintains them. She stated that the HOA has requested that the District take over the maintenance of the medians. Discussion

ensued and the Board concurred to obtain proposals for landscaping in the District, including the medians. Following review and discussion, Director Broom moved to request bids for the monthly landscape maintenance and detention maintenance, including the maintenance of the medians throughout the District, as requested by the HOA. Director Shook seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

#### MASTER PARK PLAN AND FUTURE PARK DEVELOPMENT

The Board reviewed the KGA report, a copy of which is attached.

#### OPERATION OF DISTRICT FACILITIES AND TERMINATION OF WATER AND SEWER SERVICE TO DELINQUENT CUSTOMERS

Mr. Davila reviewed the operator's report for January 2026, a copy of which is attached.

Mr. Davila reviewed a proposal to stain the perimeter fence at water plant no. 2 for an estimated cost of \$8,050.00, a copy of which is attached to the operator's report.

Mr. Davila then reviewed a proposal to replace the clarifier drive at the wastewater treatment plant for a cost not to exceed \$90,000.00.

Mr. Davila updated the Board on a water main that broke in the District. He stated that the main line belongs to an adjacent district and that all invoices will be submitted for reimbursement.

The Board next considered termination of utility service to delinquent accounts. Mr. Davila reported that the customers on the termination list were mailed written notice prior to this meeting in accordance with the Rate Order, notifying them of the opportunity to appear before the Board of Directors to explain, contest, or correct the utility service bill and to provide an explanation as to why their utility service should not be terminated for reason of nonpayment.

Following review and discussion, Director Broom moved (1) to approve the operator's report; (2) approve the proposal to stain the perimeter fence at water plant no. 2, as recommended; (3) to approve the proposal to replace the clarifier drive at the wastewater treatment plant, subject to approval by the engineering committee; and (4) to terminate utility service in accordance with procedures set forth in the Rate Order, given that the customers on the list were neither present at the meeting nor had they presented any statement on the matter. Director Shook seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

## GARBAGE COLLECTION MATTERS

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

## WEBSITE MATTERS AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Mr. VanDyk updated the Board on community outreach. Ms Dehoyos then reviewed the monthly communications report, a copy of which is attached.

## UPDATE FROM BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board discussed updates from each committee.

## MEETING DATES AND FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

The Board concurred to hold the next regular meeting on March 16, 2026, at ABHR.

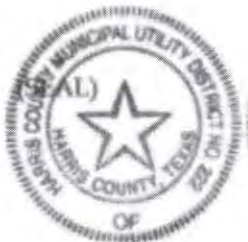
## 2026 DIRECTORS ELECTION

Mr. Pagan discussed procedures related to the 2026 Directors Election. He reviewed an Order Calling Directors Election. Following review and discussion, Director Shook moved to adopt the Order Calling Directors Election and direct that the Order be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Force seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Mr. Pagan discussed that Notice of Election may be required to be posted or published and provided to the County Clerk and Voter Registrar of Harris County. Following discussion, Director Shook moved to authorize the Secretary's agent to post or publish and provide to the County Clerk and Voter Registrar Notice of Election, if required, and to direct that the Notice be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Force seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before them, the Board concurred to adjourn the meeting.

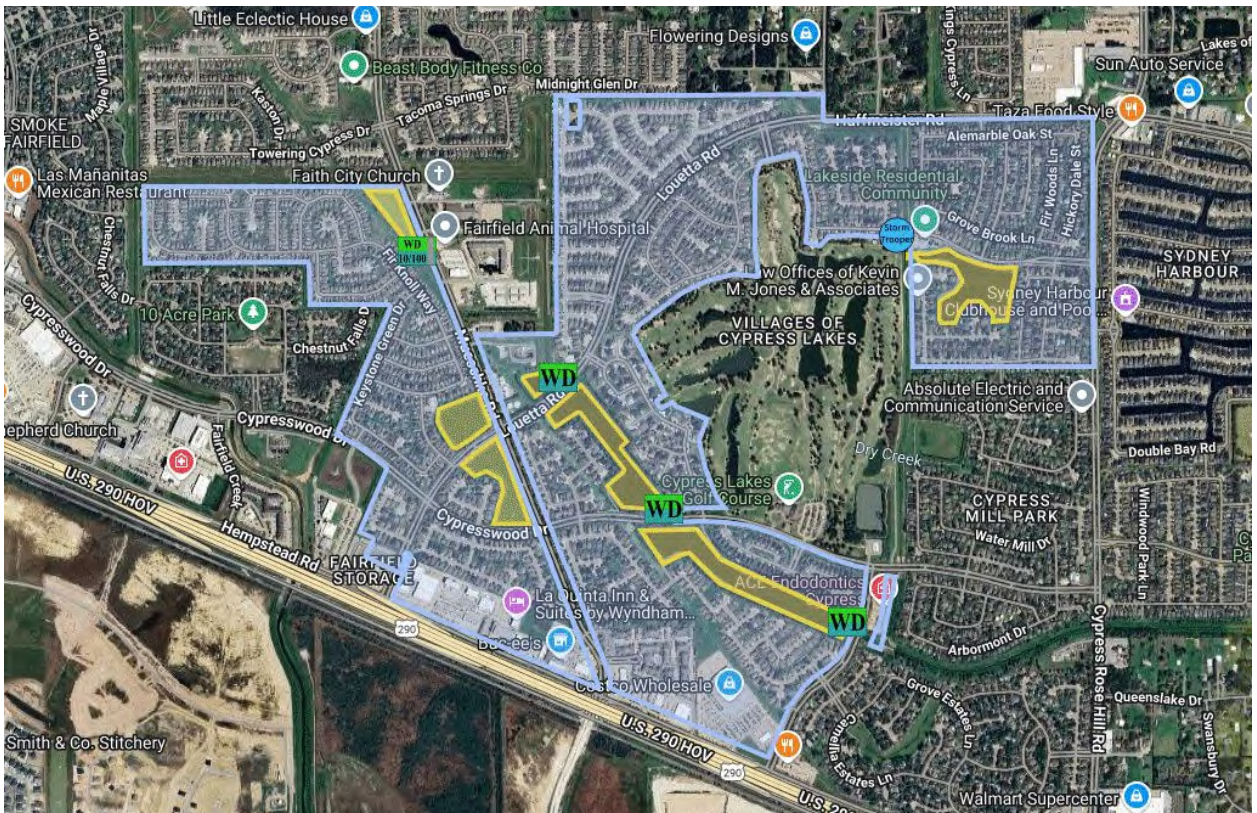

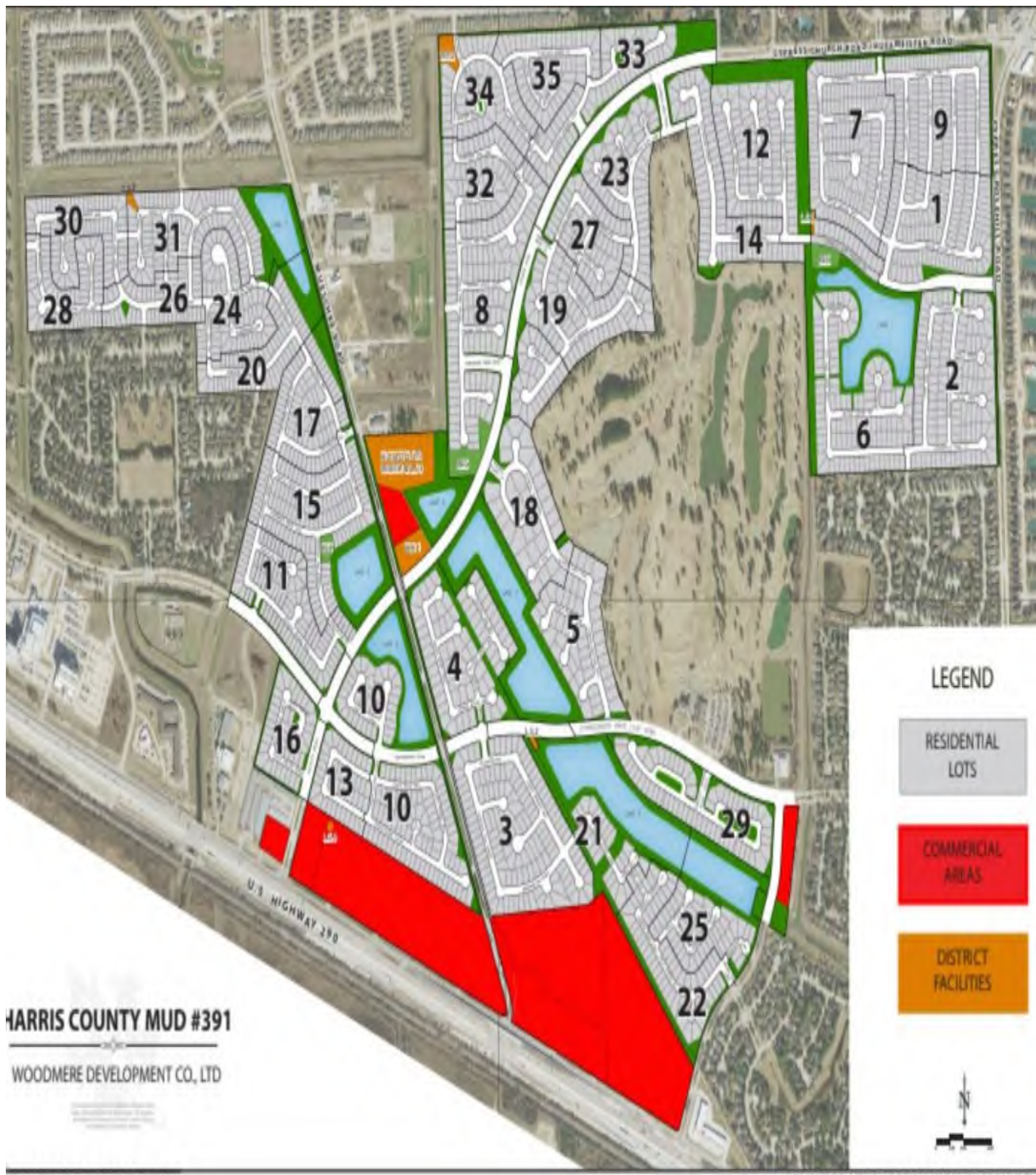

HCMUD 391 Overall Map

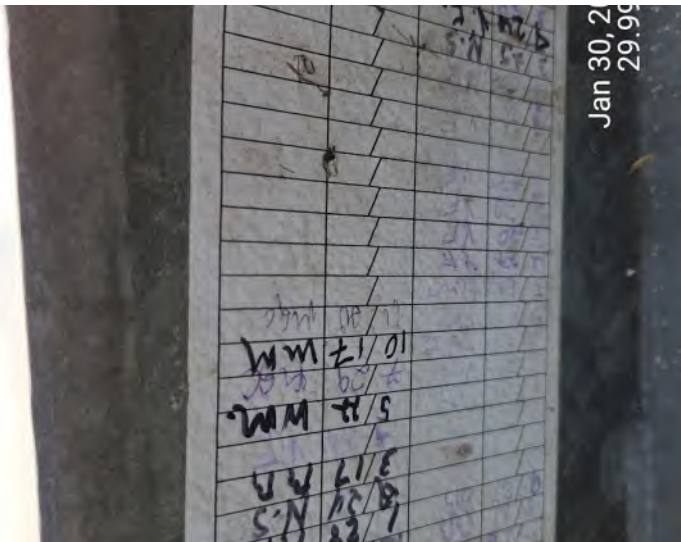

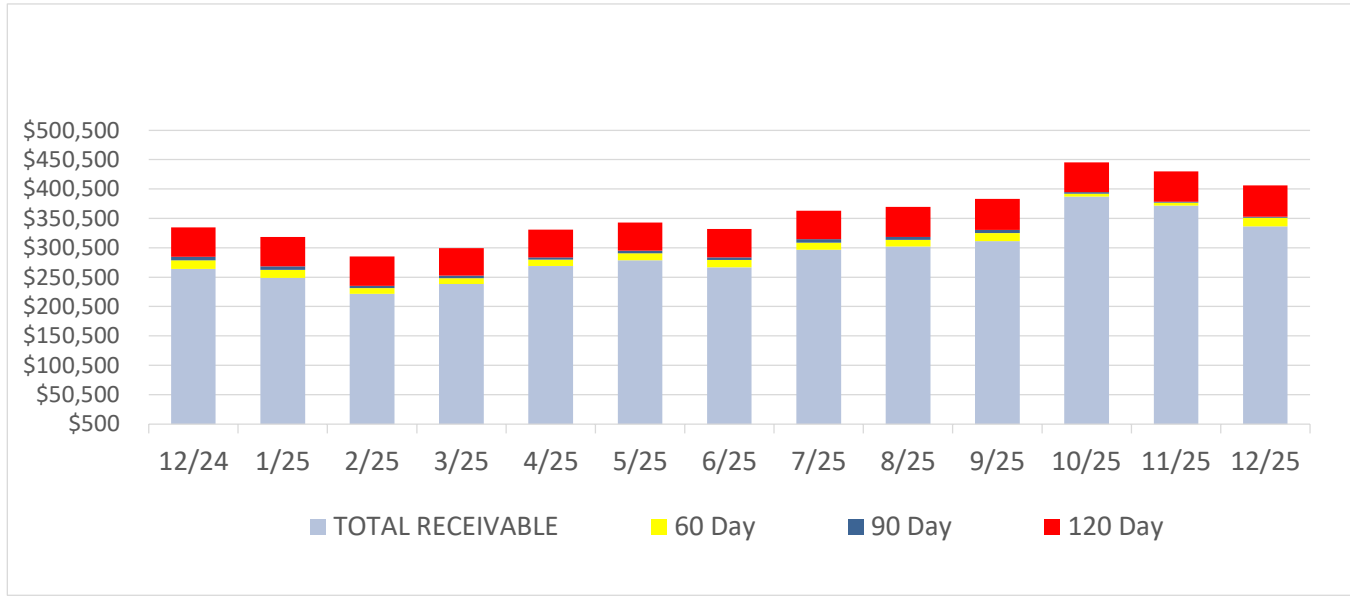

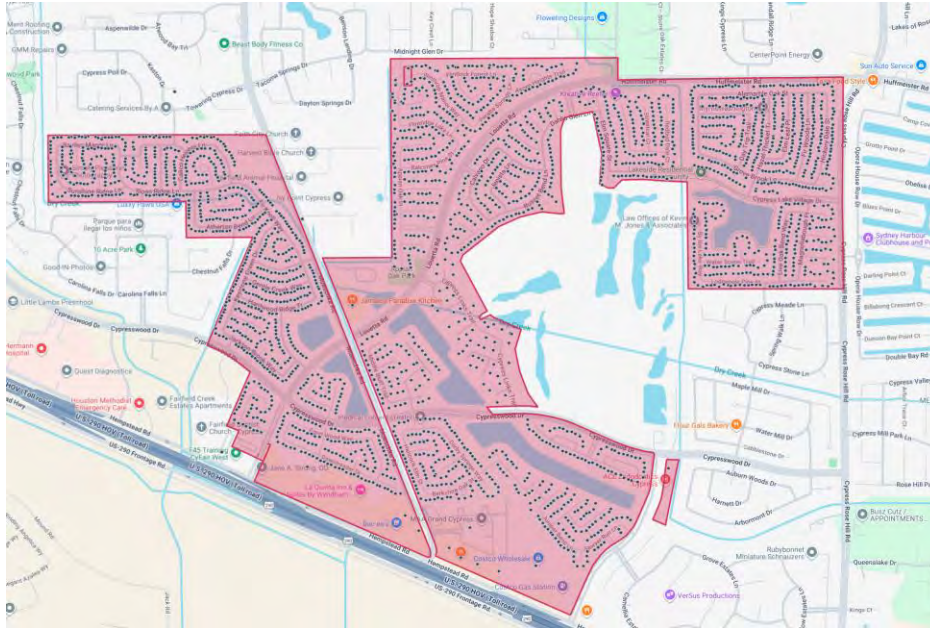
